

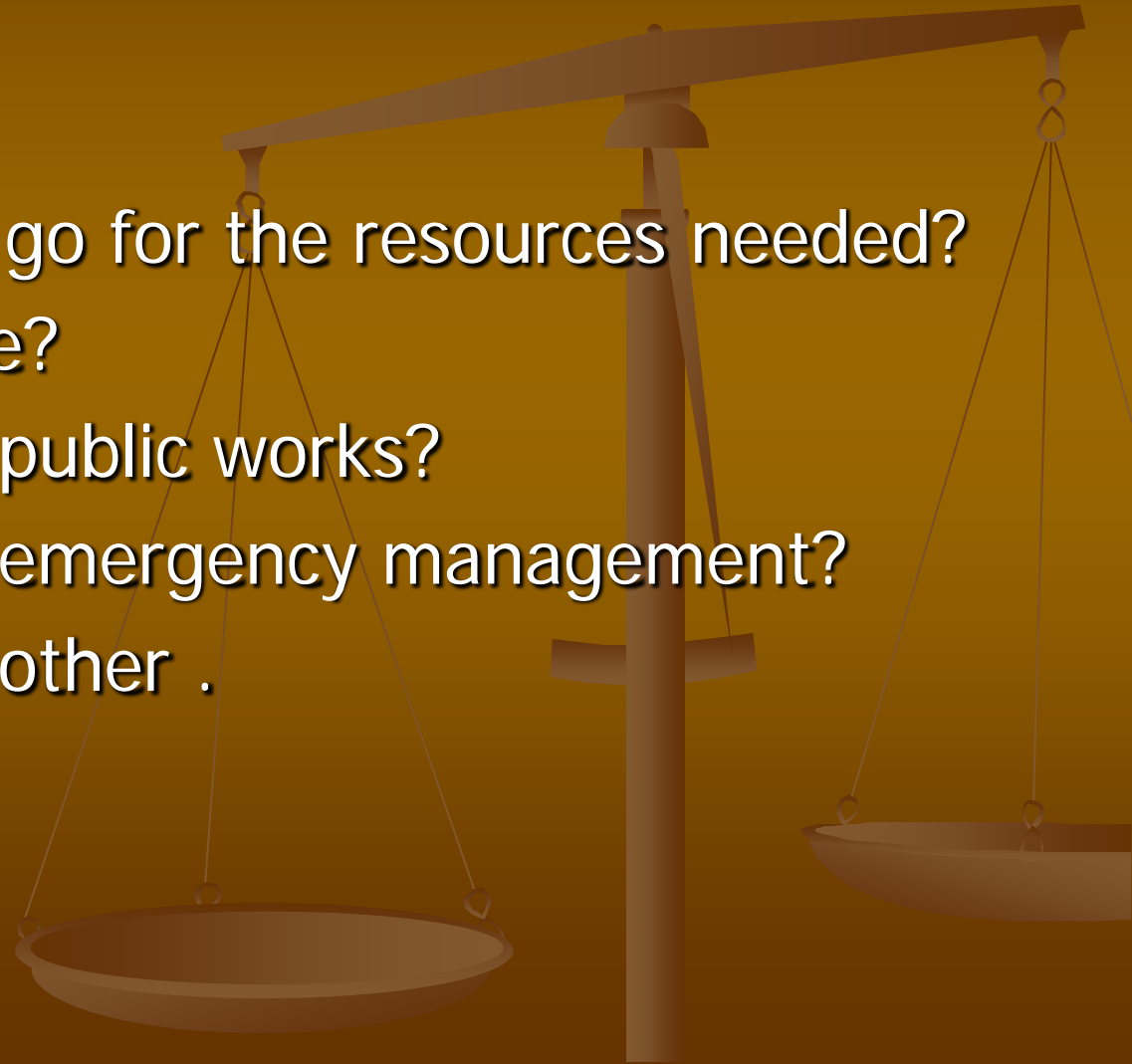

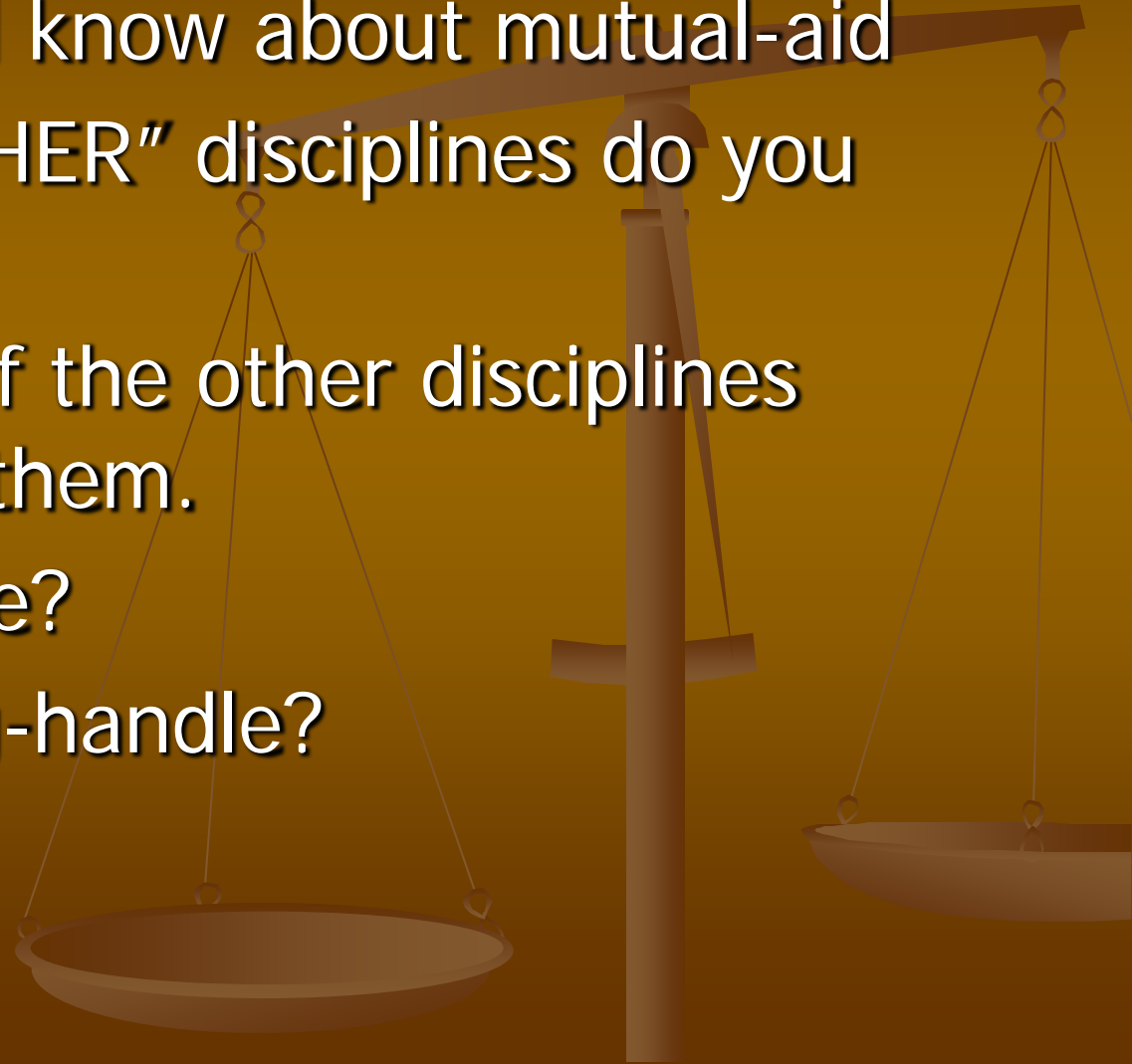
RESOURCES

- Do you train with other .



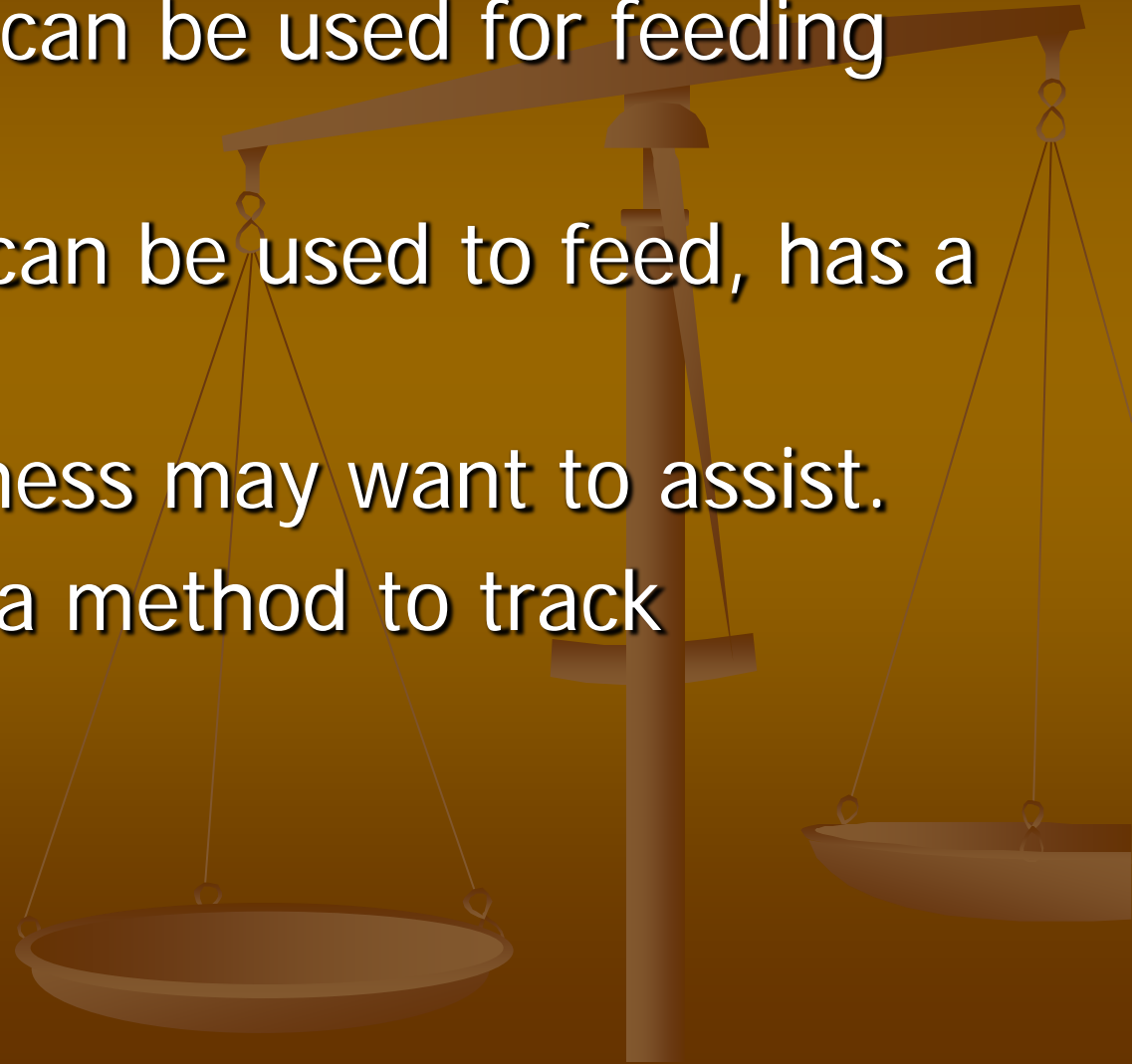
RESOURCES

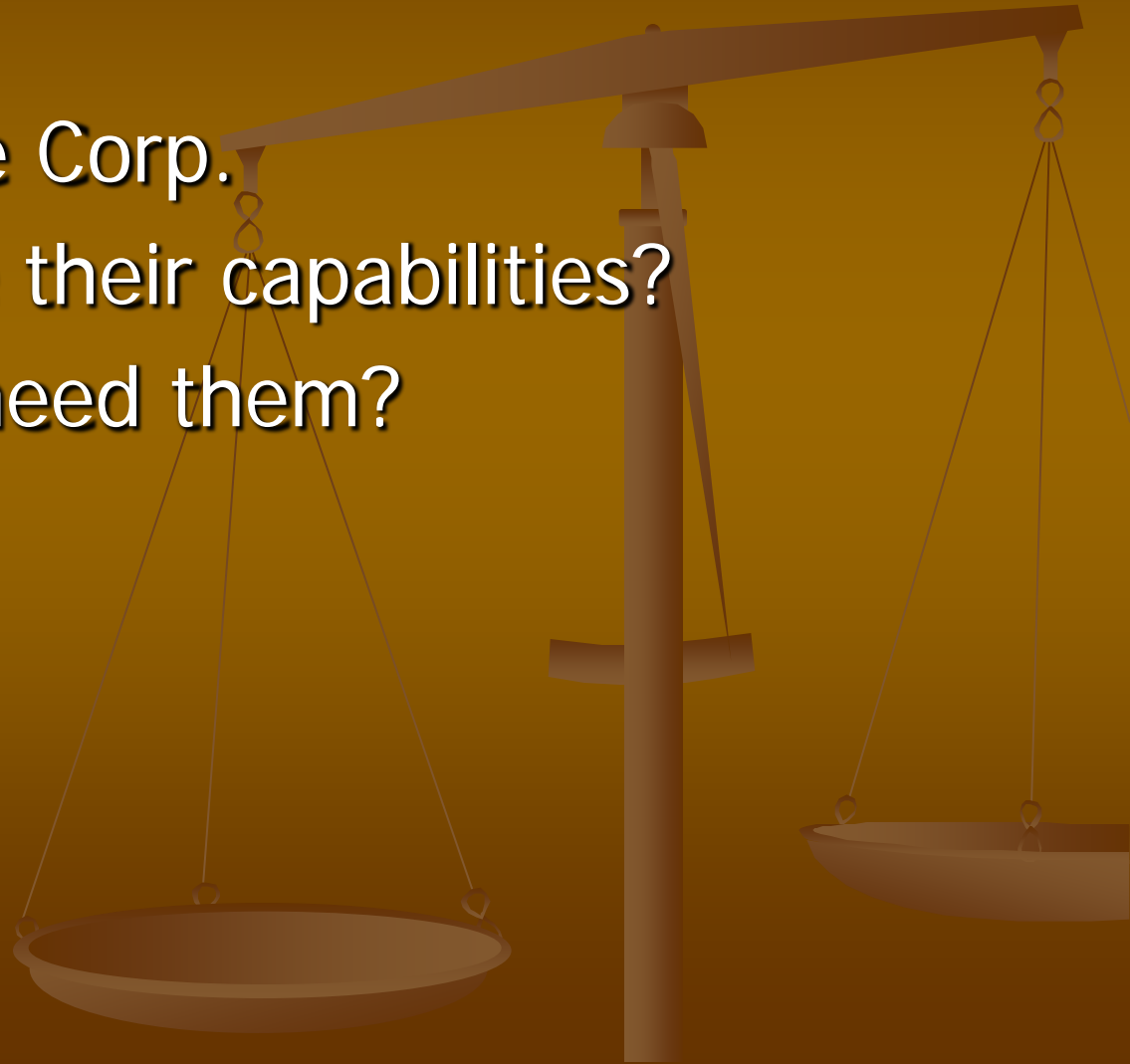

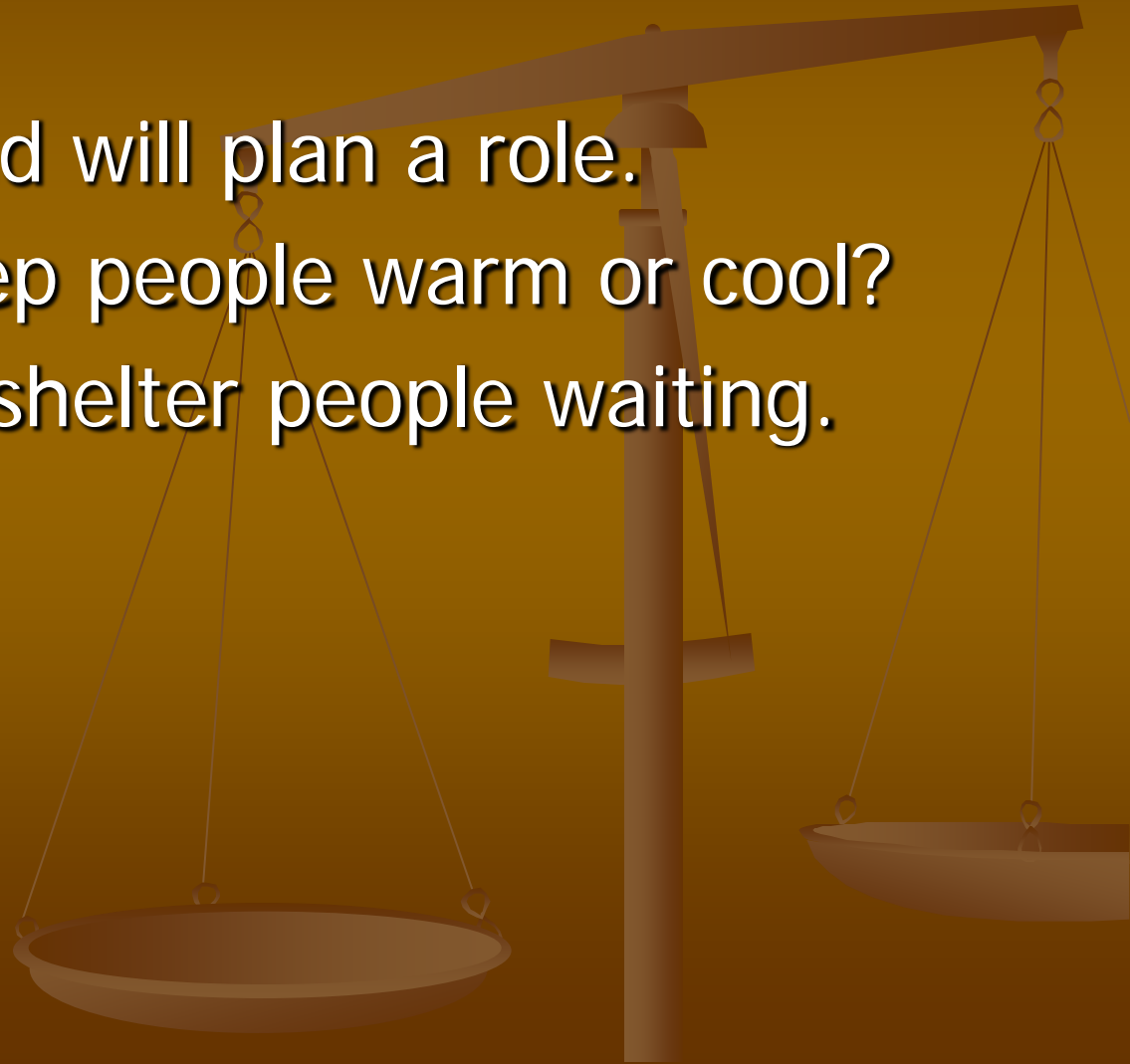

- Georgia's State Emergency Registry of Volunteers

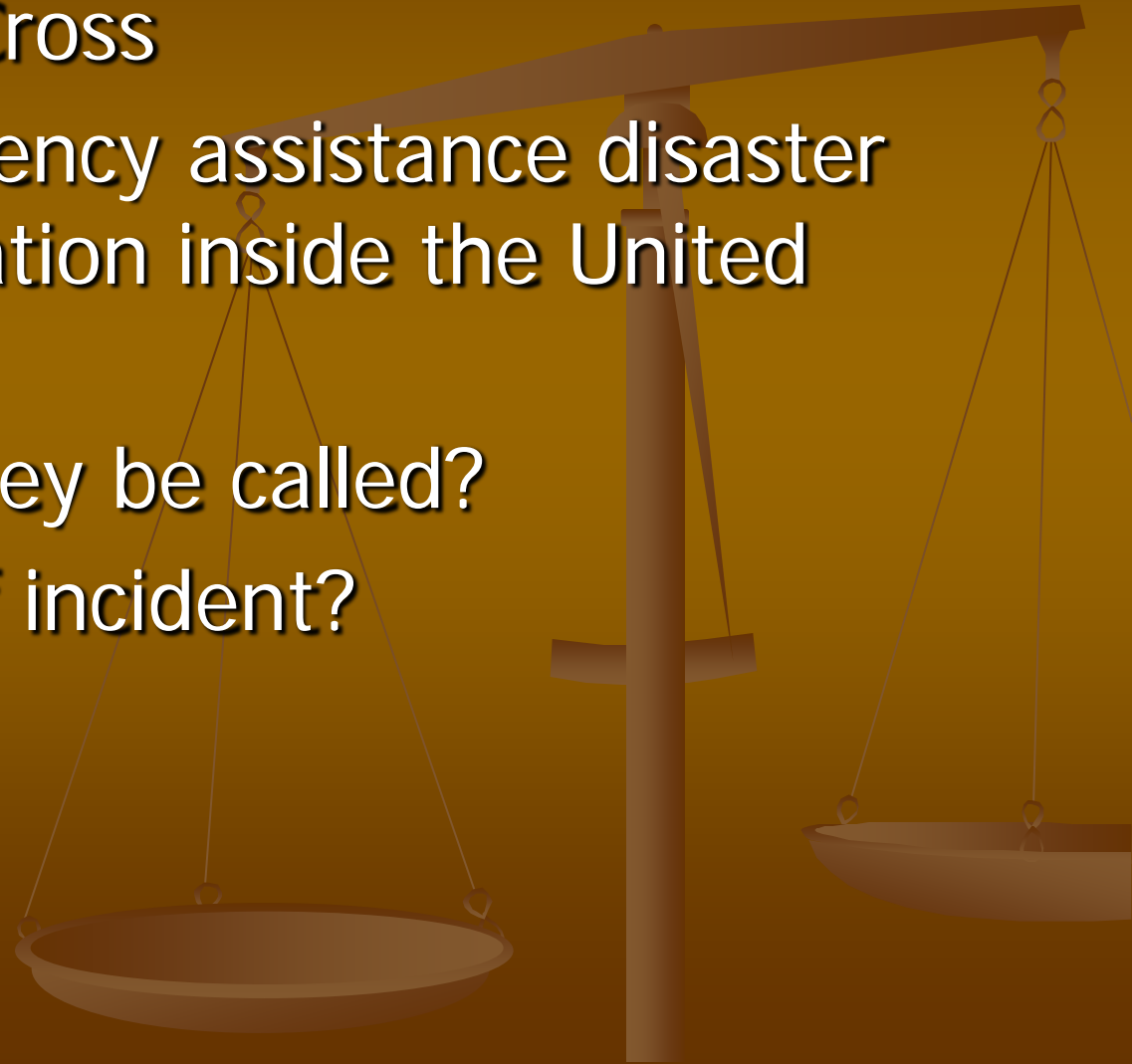

- Where will you shelter people waiting.




RESOURCES

- What type(s) of incident?

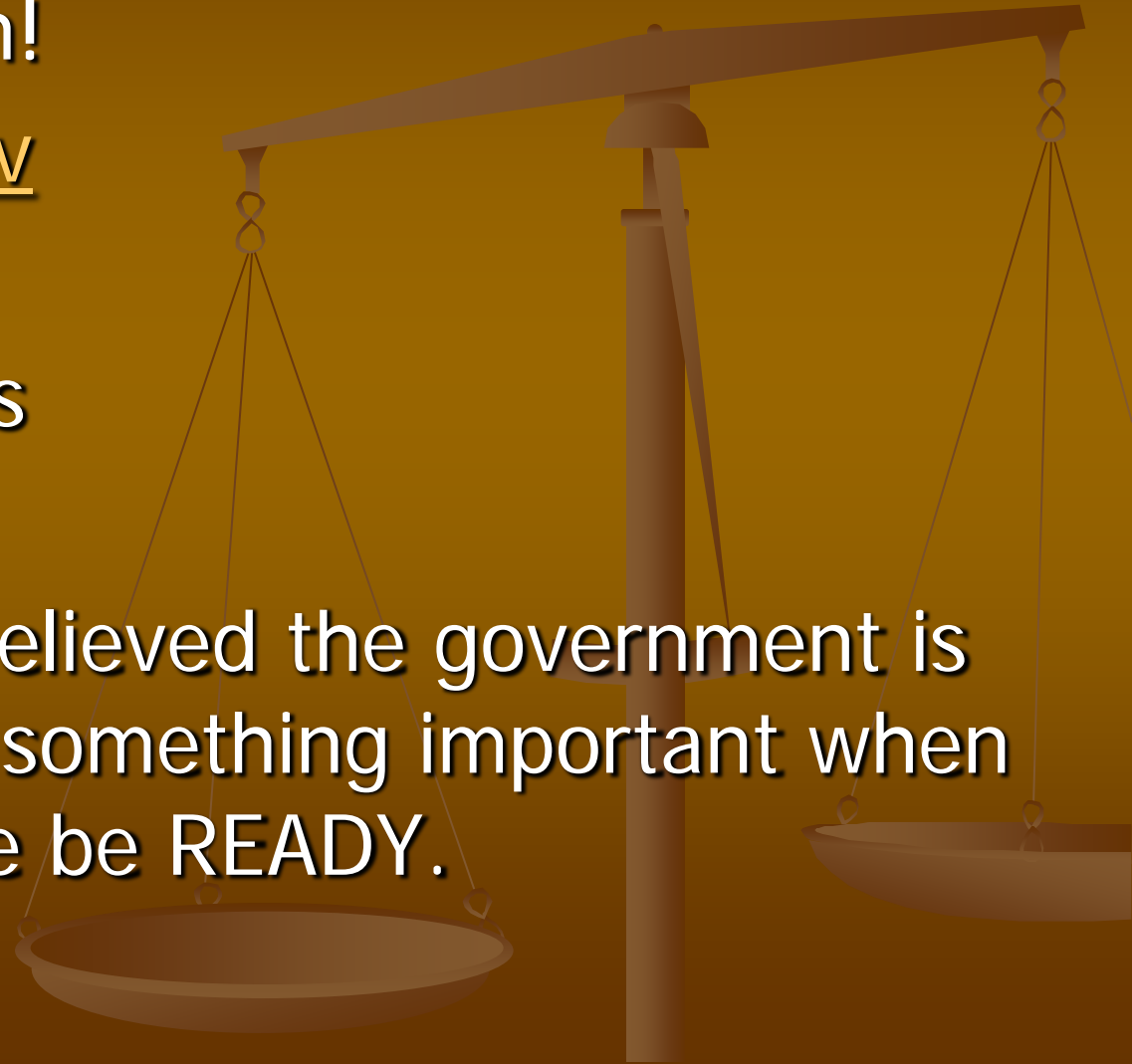


RESOURCES

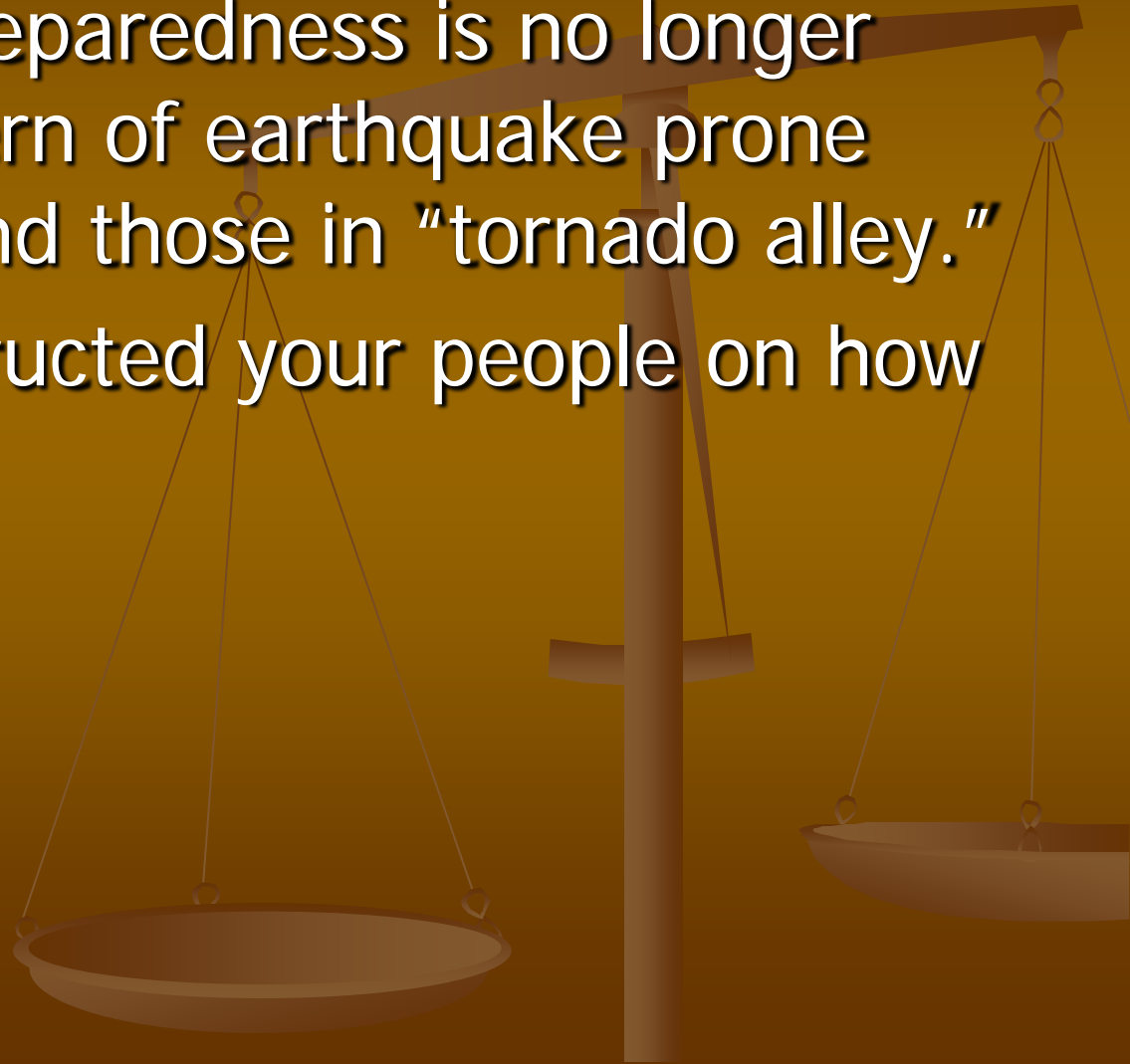

- I have always believed the government is trying to tell us something important when they suggest we be READY.



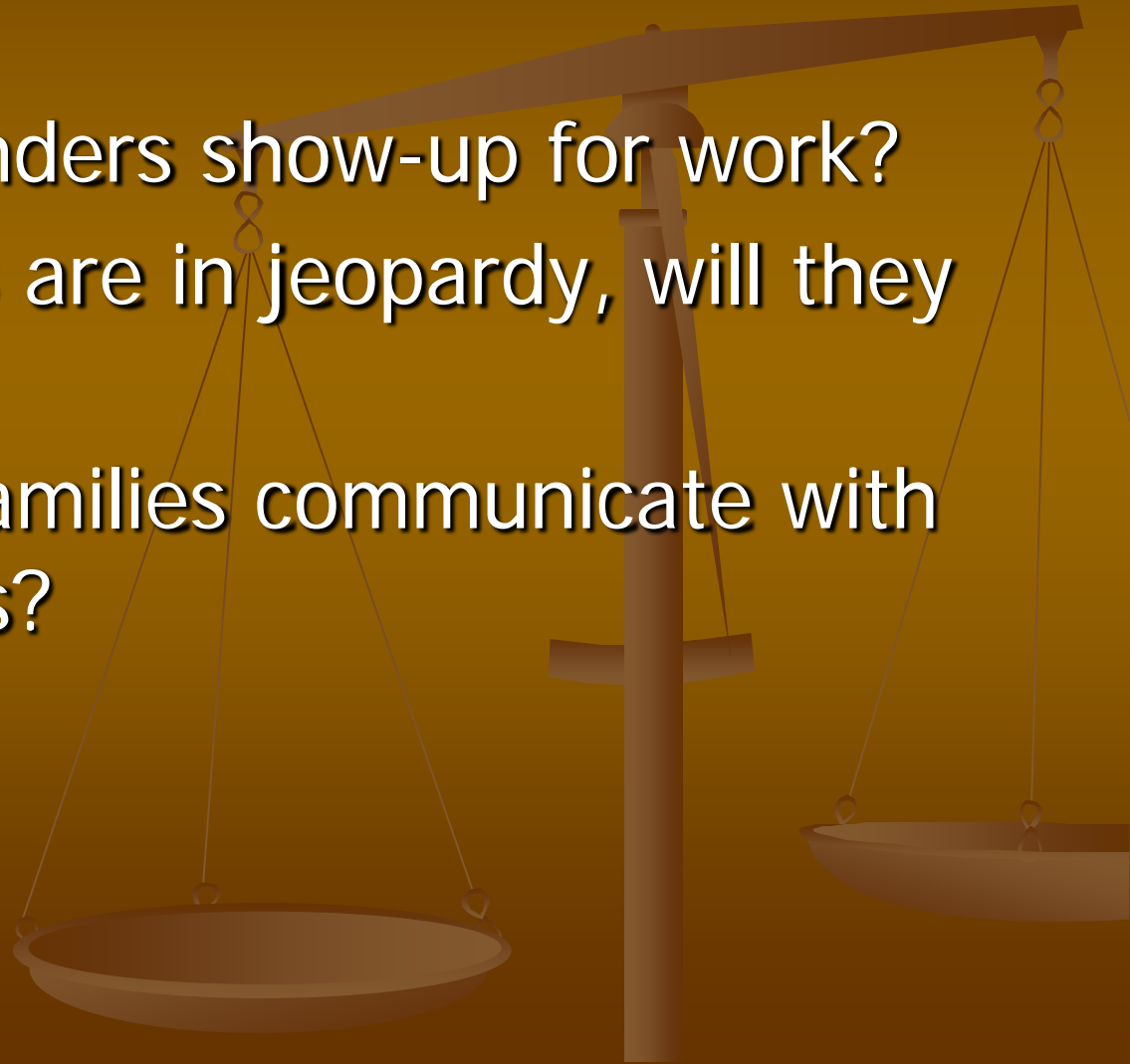
RESOURCES
